


Tuition fees include course fees, all textbooks, workbooks, stationery, selected after-school and Co-Curricular Activities and a division Year Book.

Provides Information and Communications Technology (ICT) access, insurance and repair as needed for 1-to-1 iPads (KG2-Grade 5), and 1-to-1 MacBook laptops (Grades 6-12). Each iPad and laptop comes with a protective case as the fee covers reasonable usage of the equipment, but will not cover repair costs related to misuse, water damage, screen damage, keyboard damage or physical damage. The technology fee must be paid annually prior to the student's start date, and all ICT resources remain the property of Stamford. Additional technology funded through this fee include classroom desktop computers, computer labs, Promethean boards, video-conference facilities and the hardware, software and human resources required.

Due to prevailing COVID-19 health and safety measures as well as travel restrictions from the Singapore government, we will be announcing local and /or regional academic field studies trips later in the academic year 2024/2025. All additional costs will be advised then.

Some students undergo an English language assessment upon application to the school, at which time their level of support is determined. For those requiring additional English language support, the EAL fees are mandatory and are in addition to the standard tuition fees.
